Whether you are connecting to the STL's website using a mobile app on an Android, iPhone or by computer, Lavallers can find out exactly when the bus will arrive. They can even watch the bus as it moves along its route on an interactive map.

There's more! By subscribing to MY STL, clients can select their favourite stops and receive SMS or email notifications when there is a delay or detour on their favourite bus line. They can also get real time access using Chronobus, which provides up to the minute schedules simply by dialing the stop number from their smartphone.

Lavallers also have the option of consulting one of the 84 public displays installed at our busiest bus stops or the displays provided on our buses. The screens and interactive terminals located in several public locations around Laval are also useful for keeping our clients informed.

## 20 SECOND DATA REFRESH RATES!

GPS devices installed on all our buses transmit their real time location with a 20 second refresh rate. This means that despite road conditions and unforeseen events, you can always find out exactly where the bus is.

The STL is the first public transit system in Quebec to install this technology and many other transportation companies have come to learn from us in order to develop similar applications for their own clients.

## NEW SHELTERS TO PROTECT LAVALLERS FROM THE ELEMENTS

Since 2014, the STL has been undertaking a major bus shelter replacement and building program. 68 shelters were added last year alone at 15 new locations. Over the coming year 45 additional new shelters and 38 replacement units will be added. In total, the number of new shelters will increase from 471 to 516 units, which is a significant increase of our fleet of shelters. The STL's goal is to make its services more attractive to Lavallers and increase the use of public transit.
