FREE TRAVEL DURING THE HOLIDAYS

To thank the people of Laval for their loyalty, we are offering them the chance to travel on our buses for free on December 24 and 31. The STL is taking this opportunity to combat drinking and driving and drowsy driving and ensure that thousands of Lavallers get home safe by choosing public transportation.

This initiative is also a chance to collect donations for a good cause from our riders. Last year, over \$9,000 was raised for the STL's *Boomerang* committee to support the School Food Program from the *Centre de bénévolat et moisson Laval*'s. This program provides a proper breakfast for Laval's children in need before school.

SENIORS' RESIDENCE ROUTES

The STL provides buses that are dedicated to serving several seniors' residences in Laval. These routes are designed to provide riders with a direct connection to Laval's places of interest, such as shopping centres, libraries and health centres. The STL created these routes to offer Laval's seniors access to leisure activities and help to eliminate the obstacles to social participation and foster a more inclusive society.

These eight lines offer between one and four return trips, two to three times per week from the entrance of the residence to various public locations. This service is offered at the regular fare and, Laval citizens aged 65 and over travel for free with a valid Horizon 65+ pass on their Opus card.

Providing seniors with the opportunity to travel safely and without stress is just *common sense*.
