The STL launches the 360, a new bus route to promote Laval's attractions

The new bus route will provide service to hotels and business partners surrounding the Centropolis and the Carrefour Laval as of January 19. This new service is an excellent means of positioning Laval as a unique destination!



A GROUP PROJECT

The 360 bus route will provide service to parts of downtown Laval located north of Boulevard Saint-Martin. Created in collaboration with Laval hotels, the Cosmodome, partners from the Centropolis, the Carrefour Laval and Tourisme Laval, the bus line will highlight the value of some of Laval's many points of interest.

This route is designed to meet the travel needs of the many visitors staying at hotels who do not have access to a vehicle to take them to the many areas of interest around the Centropolis and the Carrefour Laval. The route will also provide residents of Laval and Montreal with access directly from the Montmorency Metro station to points of interest. This is yet another demonstration of our common sense approach.

AN EVOLVING BUS SERVICE

The new bus route will be inaugurated as of January 19. A follow-up will be conducted to evaluate the level of interest in this service and of the frequency and points of interest. These stops will be shown on our regular displays. The STL regular fares will apply to this new service.

The schedule will change in accordance with the seasons.

January 9 to June 19, 2016: Saturday and Sunday service June 25 to August 26, 2016: Seven day a week service August 27 to December 31, 2016: Saturday and Sunday service
