WHAT'S NEW THIS FALL?

As of this August 27, there are two major changes happening at the STL. The 33 bus route is being modified to better serve customers living near boulevard Cartier and 15th Rue and the 73 bus route will now be accessible to people in wheelchairs and three and four wheel scooters. This marks yet another regular bus line on the STL network with access ramps.

FREE COLLECTIVE TAXI SERVICE

The STL is launching the T17, a free taxi service for clients and workers of the Centre Laval and the Galeries Laval. This service is designed to alleviate travel due to construction on Boulevard Le Corbusier North between Boulevard du Souvenir and Boulevard Saint-Martin for the implementation of

preferential bus measures.

BE READY FOR BACK-TO-SCHOOL

Will you be going to school by STL bus? In September, all students will need to have a valid **OPUS** card with photo ID in hand, otherwise they will have to pay the full fare, with exact change, when boarding the bus.
