#### Two months for only \$64

The XTRA fare, a special combo for the months of July and August, is available to students aged 17 years and under.

#### During summer, it is free for children

Up to five children aged 11 and younger can travel for free when accompanied by an adult paying their own fare.

Offer valid from June 1 to Labour Day.

### Free transportation 7 days a week in downtown Laval

The 360 bus line will be running for free 7 days a week, from June 24 to August 25. Go shopping with friends, go out for a bite or go on a family outing with complete peace of mind!



## Smog fare for \$1: help improve air quality!

From June 1 to Labour Day, whenever Environment Canada issues a smog alert, the STL will offer a \$1 Smog Day Fare for its regular network of buses on the following day. Implemented in 2008, this policy is the only one of its kind in Canada.



As of June 24, keep an eye out for our new summer schedules so you do not miss anything. Some of the changes include:

- Addition of a seventh accessible bus line for people with reduced mobility:
   43 bus line
- Improved service on the number 65 and 76 bus lines
- Modifications to the bus lines that serve several seniors' residences (lines 101, 106 and 107)
